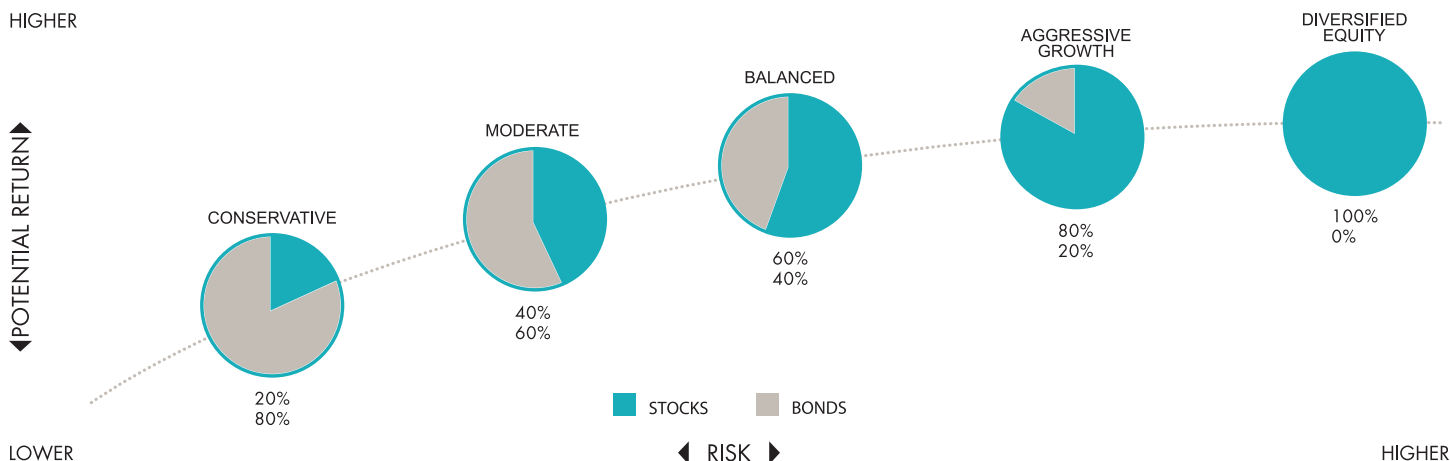


## Investment Strategies
